Easter may be over, but *Eastertide* is just beginning! Eastertide is that sacred season that begins on Easter Sunday and carries us through Pentecost. It spans a total of 50 days, practically 1/7th of the entire Christian calendar making it an annual “sabbath” of sorts where we rest in resurrection. The apostle Paul alluded to this in Romans 12 verses 4 and 5 where he noted, "For just as each of you has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others." Millersburg Christian Church's team acts together performing various roles. This calls to mind an elephant and a mouse walking together across an old, rickety bridge. Once across, the mouse said to the elephant, "We really shook that bridge, didn't we." Indeed, they did, each contributing their part large and small, to a successful effort. MCC's Membership Committee embraces the church's members. It is co-chaired by Carolyn Anderson and Vicki Fritz along with help from several others. The committee's routine duties include providing and keeping current weekly attendance sheets, updating the members and friend's directory, supporting the phone tree, maintaining the official church membership records, overseeing the Newsletter mailing, and sending care cards to church members. This committee also maintains the memorial board brass plaques created when a monetary memorial is received in the name of a departed member.

The Membership Committee regularly works with the minister on new member development, including providing the in-pew filers with a membership invitation, maintaining the guestbook in the narthex and offering a token gift sack to visitors who have come at least twice. Along with seeking new members, the committee also creates existing member activities including the first Sunday Socials, maintaining the photo wall and planning roughly seven yearly fellowship events. Included are a March event, volunteering at the Food Bank or elsewhere, an ice cream social, bonfire, bunco, bingo, and the Christmas cookie exchange; all including food!
