Healing for **Linda Mealy** who will undergo surgery on December 15. Linda is a sorority sister of Brenda Williamson.

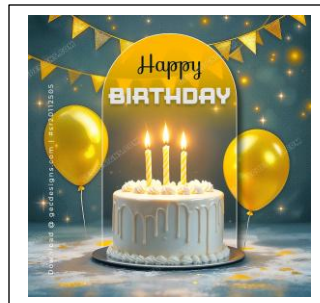

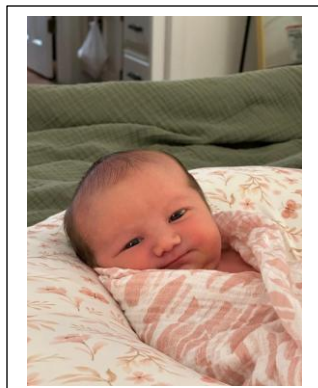

Another great month has gone by at Millersburg Preschool and we have so much more to look forward to!

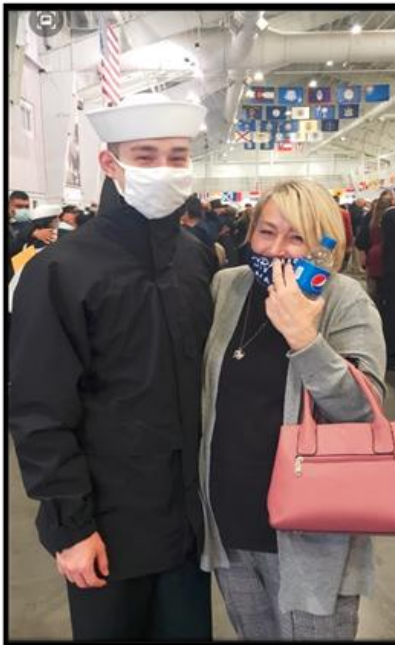

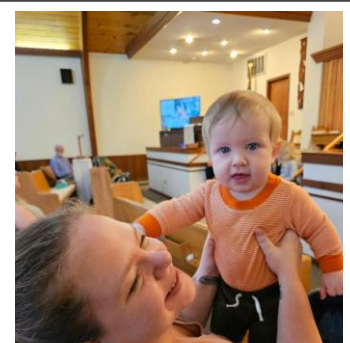


David and Judy Hosenfelt and Rita and Stan Adams at the Mizzou game on November 15.

STEWARDSHIP REPORT

A person with the wrong idea about a topic can say surprising things. For instance, a fellow joined a club and had to give an initiation talk on sex. He told his wife about joining and the required talk. She asked the topic, and to avoid embarrassment, he said sailing. Sometime later, his wife met a club member and asked how the talk went. She was surprised to hear that her husband did a wonderful job. Thinking the topic was sailing not sex, she said he had only done it twice, the first time he got sick and the second time his hat blew off.

There is some confusion about MCC's two checking accounts. The General Checking Account covers all the things in the budget and is funded through pledges and non-specific Sunday contributions. Additional income is split with the other checking account, the Special Checking Account. This joint or designated income includes a) half of the rummage sale earnings; b) half of that received from auctioning vacation time at the Green's Florida house; c) designated memorial donations, without designation they go to the Special Checking account; and d) designated grants.

The Special Checking Account isn't used on a regular basis; it helps cover extraordinary situations. The church roof, water pipes, three HVAC units, and the church's ground level underpinnings have all failed in the past few years. Each required funding beyond that considered when establishing the budget covered by the General Checking Account. The Special Checking Account was used to pay these expenses, and it grows while awaiting the next catastrophe. It is funded through the Fifth Sunday offering, the shared and designated income noted earlier, and the "refrigerator fund." This fund originated before the Special Checking Account and is \$75 that the Preschool pays monthly to assist replacing things, like a bad refrigerator, used by both entities.

The Special Checking Account is also used as a pass-through for money contributed to events like CROP walk and the Easter, Christmas, and Week of Compassion special offerings. Pass-through means that these contributions are held therein until finalized and then the total amount is passed on to their designated cause.

Some MCC members are considering using a Qualified Charitable Contribution to make their pledge or other contribution. These are IRS approved means which help reduce one's personal tax liability beyond that created by a "normal " charitable deduction. Anyone over 70½ years old, using an IRA, can do this once annually. Doing so has no impact on how the IRS views MCC or its accounts and is perfectly acceptable. Now, with this information, it is hoped that you need not hold your hat if asked about MCC's checking accounts.
